<p>Fred Talk type activities</p>	<p>Fred says:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Say: Fred says put your hands on your h-e-d. Ask children to repeat. Pause to allow children to jump in with the whole word and do the action. Say: h-e-d, hed. Ask children to repeat. Repeat with: b-a-k, t-u-m, l-e-g, h-a-n-d, f-u-t, n-ee, r-u-n, s-k-i-p, h-o-p, s-t-o-p <p>Fred I spy:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> Say: Fred says 'I spy something r-e-d' Ask children to repeat. Pause to allow children to 'jump-in' with the whole word and point to something red. Say: r-e-d, red. Ask children to repeat.
