Standard Uniform

White polo shirt	
Grey or black trousers/skirt/pinafore/shorts	Skirt of reasonable length and design
Black/white/grey socks or tights (no leggings)	
Grey school sweatshirt, cardigan or fleece jacket with the school logo	School logo is preferred but not essential. Available from Screenprint, 72 Stennack Road, St Austell. 01726 68689
Yellow and white checked school dress or playsuit for summer	Optional
Black school shoes/all black trainers with black sole and black logo	No sandals

Note: No long-sleeved base layers to be worn under t-shirts.

PE Kit

Item	Details
Black polo shirt with St Mewan logo (or plain black polo shirt)	School logo is preferred but not essential. Available from Screenprint, 72 Stennack Road, St Austell. 01726 68689
Black shorts or skort (plain, unbranded or with a small brand label - no branded team kit)	Cycle shorts are permitted for PE. Shorts and skorts should be of reasonable length.
Plimsolls or trainers	
Black hoodie with St Mewan logo (or plain black hoodie – no zips)	School logo is preferred but not essential. Available from Screenprint, 72 Stennack Road, St Austell. 01726 68689
Black tracksuit bottoms for cold weather	Optional
One piece swimming costume or trunks for swimming lessons	No bikinis

Note: Reception children do not need any PE kit in the Autumn or Spring terms. Parents are welcome to purchase PE kit for the Summer term but this is not essential.

Jewellery

- For safety reasons, children should not wear jewellery at school. Rings, necklaces and bracelets are not allowed.
- For health and safety reasons, children may only wear one pair of small, simple stud earrings in the ear lobe. Earrings must be removed for PE lessons or taped. If removed, it is the responsibility of the child to ensure that they are kept safe during this time; it is not the responsibility of the teacher.
- No make-up is permitted. Nail varnish, temporary tattoos, false nails and extensions are also not allowed.
- Watches may be worn. These can be analogue, digital or step counter watches but not smart watches. These will need to be removed for PE lessons.

Hair

- Longer hair should be tied back for school (shoulder length and longer).
- Mohicans, extreme hairstyles, shaved lines and tramlines are not permitted.
- Hair accessories should be understated and small in size.
- Dyed hair should be of a natural colour.
